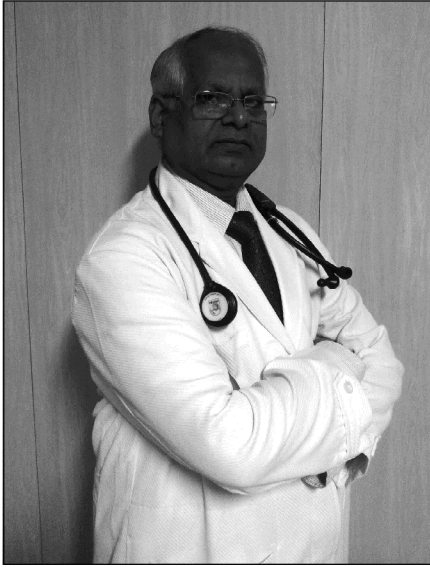


## *From The Editors Desk*

In the present era of rapidly progressing interventional cardiology well equipped with OCT and IVUS imaging modulites rotational Atherectomy, intravascular lithotripsy etc to over come and treatra more complex cases without surgical option in lights of availability of cheaper stents hence Homo multi vessel Coronary Artery disease can be safely treated by multi vessel PCI.

Gokhroo et al Authors have given one year follow up wit respect to multi vessel PCI are encouraging results. It not only decreased hospital cost but also morbidity and is more economically viable.
